

### Introduction

We would like to start the necessary services first. The additional services described in this proposal will be brought online as demand increases.

Should I be granted the bid, an important part of my plan will be creating *Local First* initiatives. 




### Site Overview

#### Passenger Vehicles / Cars

- The main entrance will be relocated to the West side of the property, directly across from the rest area exit.
- Relocating the entrance will not only improve the appearance of the property, but will also create a safe and efficient traffic flow pattern on the property.
- Cars will have their own dedicated lane from the main entrance, which will lead them to the fuel dispensers, or to parking in front of the building.
- Vehicles will then be able to depart the property through the current East exit.
- The convenience store will be surrounded by strategically placed and aesthetically pleasing barriers that will prevent vehicles from accidentally or intentionally driving into or damaging the building.





### Site Overview

### Commercial Truck Parking

- Relocating the entrance will open the West lot to semi trucks that can pull into dedicated stalls.
- This arrangement will provide a convenient, dedicated area for truck drivers to park their rigs while they grab a shower, purchase food, snacks or drinks.
- Trucks exit through a dedicated path behind the main building and depart through the East exit drive.
- The path will be created by digging up the hillside on the south side of the property and installing a retaining wall. There will be no easement changes or alterations.
- The exit drive will be improved and expanded in order to properly serve exiting semi trucks and passenger vehicles.
- The separated commercial truck traffic flow will also effectively negate the chances of truck and small car collisions on the property.


# Garage

### Repair & Service Shop


- There will be a service shop with a certified mechanic who will be able to perform services such as:

## Other Offerings



### Propane Cylinder Exchange

- Primary usage would be for local residents.
- Many summer travelers will also likely take advantage of a propane bottle exchange program.
- There will also be a larger propane tank for refilling non standard bottle sizes.



### Red dyed (off-road) diesel

 Due to the configuration of the underground storage tanks, we will be able to also sell Off Road diesel to local Farmers, Ranchers and residents who can utilize it.

### FUTURE DEVELOPMENT:



#### **Propane Delivery:**

We would like to develop a propane delivery service to local residents who own their propane tanks. The propane will be priced competitively and free of ridiculous "emergency delivery" and "leak check" fees.

#### **Fuel Delivery:**

In addition, if the local farmer and rancher demand for fuel grows above and beyond the pump availability, the possibility of fuel deliveries will be entertained.





### Other Offers

### Chugwater Water

- To develop more interest into, as well as recognition of the area, we would like to also offer a "Chugwater Water" brand of drinking water.
- The water will be bottled by a local bottling company under a private label.
- In addition to the Chug-Chug logo, the labels can be printed with other local business logos or other advertising information, should any local businesses choose to participate in this promotion program.
- We would like to donate 10 cents per bottle sold in order to help offset any Town sponsored programs or events for the residents, should the Council accept the donation.

#### Two Night Employees


One cashier and one multi-area employee who will fill several roles such as stocking and cleaning

If the mechanic is a local resident, then he or she can be on call


#### Floaters

Four part-time floaters will fill in as necessary for time off requests as well as emergency relief



# Fully Staffed

- At full staffing levels, we plan on employing 25 full and part-time employees.
  - Convenience Store Thirteen Employees
  - **Kitchen** Five Employees
  - Garage Two Employees
  - Restaurant Four Employees
  - **Deliveries** One Employee
  - Employees will be dressed professionally and will wear clean Polo shirts with the Chug-Chug logo. This will help identify them to our customers as Chug-Chug team members.





### **Ambulance Services**

- The Town of Chugwater needs E.M.T. personnel for the Ambulance that's currently not being used due to a lack of certified personnel.
  - I am a big believer in helping my employees better themselves through education and advancement.
  - Currently, there are on-line options that take between 40 and 50 hours to complete and will certify an individual as an Intermediate Level Paramedic. (E.M.T.)
  - If the Town or Council decides to reinstate the Ambulance program and any non E.M.T. certified employees or residents are hired for the position by the Town, then we are willing to pay for the new personnel's E.M.T. certification program costs.
  - This offer can potentially help someone who may not be able to afford the program but is interested in further pursuing his or her career goals and aspirations.









### Law Enforcement

- There are grants for rural Law Enforcement programs that can help small communities with acquiring a Law Enforcement presence.
- Should the Town Council choose to start a Law Enforcement Program or hire a local Law Enforcement Officer, I will pledge up to 50% of the officer's yearly salary, depending on profit margins.
- Based on various present factors, this could be as much as \$30,000 per year.







# Supporting the Community

- Chugwater residents will receive
   10% off of Convenience Store purchase.\*
- Chugwater residents will also receive a 3 cent per gallon discount off the posted gas and diesel price.







\*This would be all kitchen, grab and go food and drink items and groceries. Cigarettes, fish and game licenses, gasoline, alcohol would be excluded from discount. Local vendors selling within the store would be allowed to participate if they so choose to.



# Supporting those in the Military

- Any Active Duty or Veteran Military residents of Chugwater will receive an additional 5% off over and above the 10% discount for Convenience Store purchases\*
- Non-resident Active Duty or Veteran Military customers will also receive the aforementioned additional 5% off discount.
